Activity 1: Leaf Art Fun

3. Under each picture, write its name (for example, "Leaf Bird" or "Flower Face").
4. Show your leaf art in class when school reopens!

Discover the length of your ancestry. After doing some research, create a family tree based on either your father's side or your mother's side or both.
