Activity 1: Make a word puzzle of 10x10 grids for the given below words: stomata, chlorophyll, leaf, oxygen, glucose, sun, nutrition, air, soil, water, nitrogen, autotroph, chemical, algae, root

Activity 2: Grow the bread mould and record your observations.

Steps of growing bread mould:

- 1. Spritz the bread with few sprays of water to make it damp.
- 2. Place the moistened bread in the Ziploc bag and seal it tightly, leaving some air inside.
- 3. Store the bag in a warm, dark location like a kitchen cupboard or a closet, away from direct sunlight.
- 4. Check the bread every few days. Mould growth may start in 2-3 days, but it can take a week or more to get a good sample.
- 5. If the bread becomes dried out, add a few more spritzes of water.
- 6. Once the experiment is complete, discard the bread and the bag in the trash.

Note: Take a picture of yours with the bread mould and paste it on the sheet.

Attempt any three tasks:

TASK 1: VERB VOYAGE CHALLENGE

Objective:

Enhance your understanding of verb forms by exploring and documenting them in a creative and organized manner.

Assignment:

Title: Verb Voyage: Exploring 100 Verbs and Their Forms

Instructions:

1. Create a Verb Journal:

- Design a journal titled "Verb Voyage."
- Divide it into sections based on themes such as:

 - Lunchtime Laughs
 - River Rides

- Unexpected Surprises
- Evening Encounters
- Reflections and Dreams

2. List of Verbs:

- ✓ Summarize the main events and storyline in your own words.
- ✓ Discuss the main characters, focusing on their traits and development.
- ✓ Write any one Character analysis which inspire you.
- ✓ Explain the moral lessons conveyed.

TASK 3: A VISIT TO AN ORPHANAGE/OLD AGE HOME A Reflective Diary Entry

Objective:

To cultivate empathy, enhance reflective writing skills, and encourage social awareness by documenting personal experiences and feelings.

Instructions:

Visit Experience:

During your summer vacation, visit an orphanage or an old age home. Engage with the residents, participate in activities, and observe the environment.

Diary Entry Composition:

Write a diary entry of 150–200 words detailing your visit.

Include the following elements:

Date and Time: Start your entry with the date and time of your visit.
